2016 Cravens Place Shiraz

The fruit for Cravens Place is sourced from the rich red soils at the northern end of the Heathcote region. The wine is made in an immediately approachable and more modern style, focusing on plenty of upfront primary fruit flavours and a soft, smooth tannin profile. Aged for 12 months with fine grained American oak, this is fantastic Heathcote Shiraz that delivers well beyond its price.

Colour: Rich deep concentrated red.

Nose: Cherries, plum, spice and dark chocolate notes.

Palate: Dark cherries, currants, raspberries, and mocha.

Cellaring: Intended for drinking on release, or cellar up to 4 to 6 years.

Alcohol: 14.5%

Vine Age: 21 years

Soil Type: Red Cambrian

Irrigation: Minimal irrigation
